




More Settings

Outgoing Authentication


- Y Select the 'Outgoing Server' tab
- Y Ensure 'My outgoing server (SMTP) requires authentication' is ticked
- Y Select 'Use same settings as my incoming mail server'



Step 7

Sever Port Number

- Y Select the 'Advanced' tab
- Y Select 'This server requires an encrypted connection (SSL)' for the 'Incoming server (POP3)'. This will automatically change the 'Incoming server (POP3)' Port number to 995.
- Y Change the 'Outgoing server (SMTP)' port number to 587.
